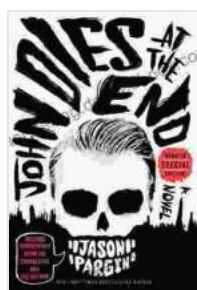


# John Dies at the End: A Surreal, Mind-Bending, and Hilarious Horror Comedy

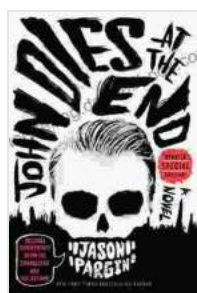

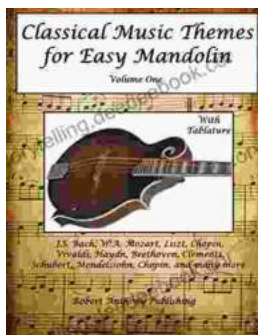
