


A Lasting Legacy

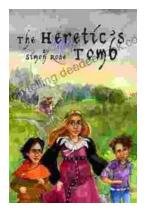
